This is a Spitfire. In 1940 it was one of the RAF's most important fighters and played a key role in stopping the Nazis from invading Britain in "The Battle of Britain". However, it is wartime so recycling is even more important than normal. There are six rectangles of Perspex (a plastic they made the canopy from) on this page. If the area of the rectangle matches the area of a section of the Spitfire's canopy it can be reshaped to make it fit. Can you work out which piece of Perspex we don't need?
