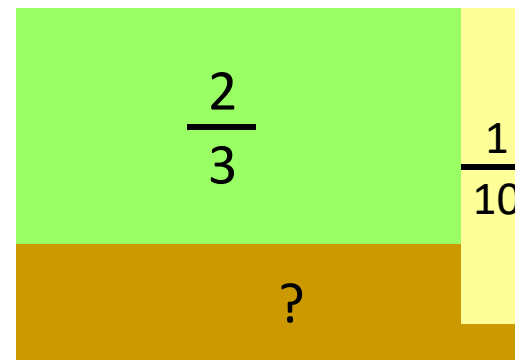
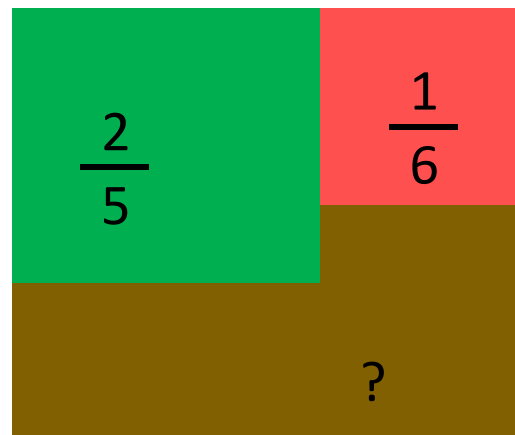
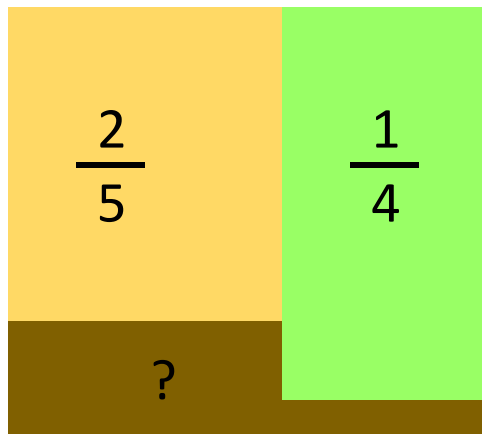
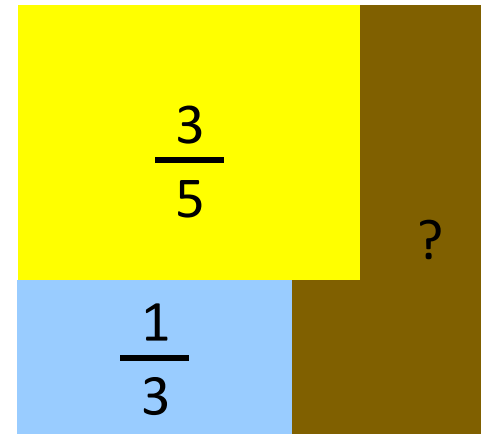
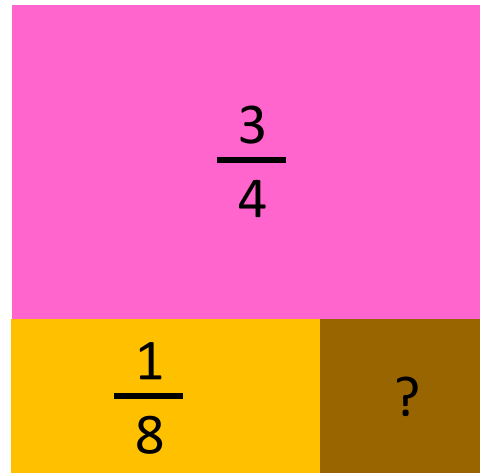
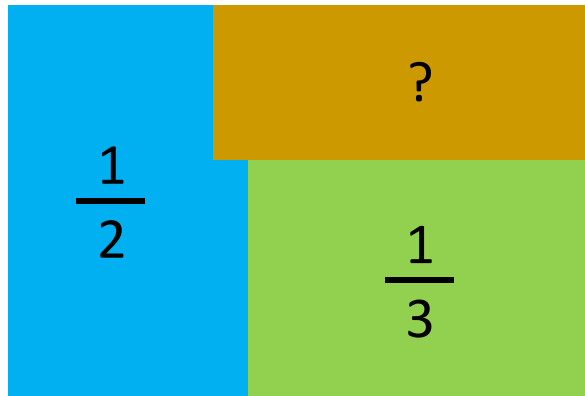


This is Claude Monet. He is one of the most famous painters of all time. He worked with other painters in a group called "The Expressionists". His paintings are so popular they sell for a fortune - one picture of some waterlilies sold for \$84.6 million! Monet was very precise about the colours he used. Below are six of his palettes, and the fraction of different coloured paints he used. There is a gap on each palette. Work out the fraction that is left and match it to the tubes of paint on the right. When you have finished there will be one tube left - Monet can put that one away for another day!
